

## **Objective:**

To boost employee self-confidence, foster teamwork, enhance interpersonal communication, and build resilience and problem-solving skills through immersive outdoor activities in a dynamic environment.

# Target Group:

Corporate teams comprising 20–30 participants from diverse departments.

## **Program Duration:**

**2 Days** Weekend Program: **Saturday and Sunday** 

## Venue:

**Vangni Campsite** A scenic and natural location designed for outdoor adventure activities.

# **Program Outline:**

#### Day 1: Setting the Foundation

Morning:

- Welcome and Orientation: Introduction to the program objectives, safety guidelines, and an icebreaker session to establish camaraderie.
- **Team Formation Activity:** Teams are formed with a mix of roles and departments to encourage diverse interaction.
- Activity 1: Leadership and Trust Exercise Blindfold Trek
- Participants guide their blindfolded teammates through a short natural trail, focusing on trust, communication, and collaboration.



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# Corporates

#### Afternoon:

- Activity 2: Confidence Builder High Ropes Course
- Teams navigate suspended rope bridges and zip lines, helping participants step out of their comfort zones while promoting team encouragement.
- Activity 3: Communication Challenge Mystery Box
- Teams solve a series of clues to unlock a box, emphasizing clarity in communication and logical thinking.

#### Evening:

• **Campfire Session:** A reflective gathering where participants share insights, and facilitators discuss the importance of mutual respect and leveraging team diversity.

#### Day 2: Strengthening Synergy

#### Morning:

- Activity 4: Problem Solving and Team Building Raft Building
- Teams brainstorm, allocate resources, and work together to construct and navigate a raft across a water body.
- Activity 5: Overcoming Fears Rock Climbing
- Participants tackle a challenging rock face with guidance and moral support from their team members, building resilience and confidence.

#### Afternoon:

- Activity 6: Collaborative Strategy Survival Island
- Teams simulate a survival scenario by creating shelters, purifying water, and starting a fire, highlighting strategic planning and adaptability.
- Closing Activity: Synergy Circle
- Participants gather to reflect on their experiences, share key takeaways, and celebrate individual and team achievements.
